- To meet ANL & DOE Quality Assurance Requirements
- To provide an efficient way of doing business.

Key Features:

- Based upon efficient predefined processes design to produce a predefined results, rather than ad-hoc/learn as you processes that then to go astray.
- Based on existing APS QA plan and existing processes. (User friendly, web-based format versus text-bases QA plan.)
- Hypertext, links and process flowcharts designed to assist the person doing the work (24 hours a day)
- Quality Level Dictionary designed to allow ANL LCLS workers to find the Quality Level for each ANL LCLS Activity.
- Process Flowcharts with more/less quality requirements depending on the Quality Level
- Future of QA. (ANL & APS want to adopt the same approach)
